Flourish, grow, boom - believe in the African renaissance. Rich earth tones with gold and copper.

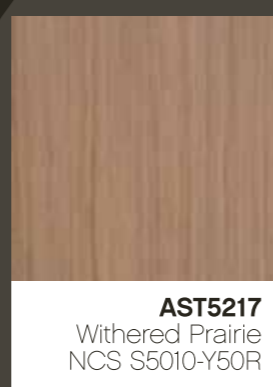
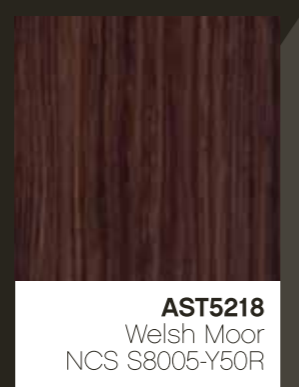
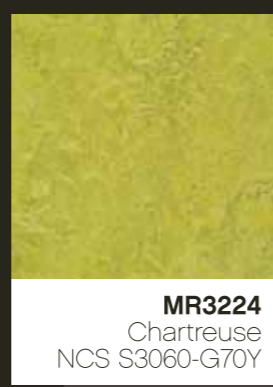
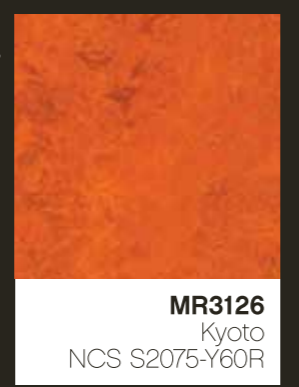




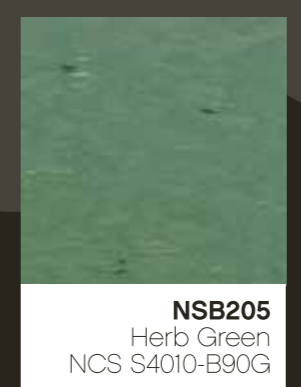
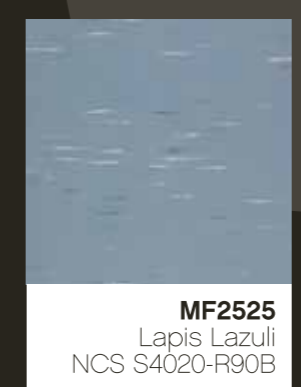
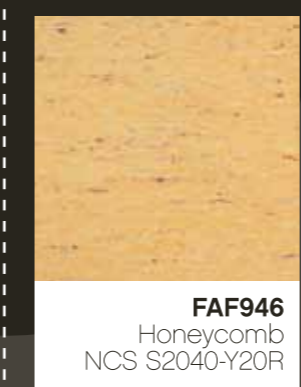
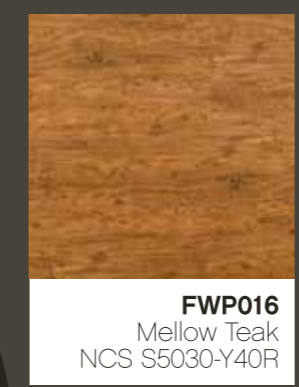
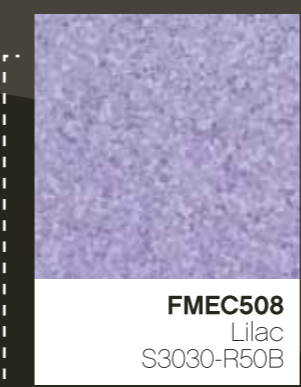
